At ITB Panel meeting on 28 January 2014, during discussion of policy initiatives relating to ICT development featured in the 2014 Policy Address, Members requested information on ICT products that are developed locally and the measures we have put in place to assist their promotion. We have set out at the **Annex** some examples of the winning applications developed in Hong Kong, many of which have earned international accolades, for Members' reference.

These products represent a good part of Hong Kong's accomplishments in ICT. We have undertaken a number of measures to promote Hong Kong's outstanding ICT products, both within and outside Hong Kong, including putting in place a "Made in Hong Kong" zone in the ICT Fair on 20 April 2014, arranging Hong Kong ICT Awards winners interested to participate in expositions and trade shows (e.g. International ICT Expo, International Soft China in Beijing, China International Software and Information Service Fair in Dalian, InnoCarnival, etc) to showcase their products as well as publishing advertorials in newspapers and computer journals to highlight these achievements. We will continue to look for suitable channels to promote these locally-made products.
