Statement in support of ITB

To maintain and enhance Hong Kong's competitive position as a world-class smart city, we must leverage the entrepreneurial spirit of its citizens and businesses, a major source of strength in Hong Kong.

How can we do that?

We need to build on the most advanced and powerful tools at our disposal, especially in the area of computing and communications technologies. More importantly, we need to learn how to use these tools to benefit all the stakeholders in the city, especially our citizens and businesses.
