Bills

Resumption of Second Reading debate, Committee stage and Third Reading

Mandatory Provident Fund Schemes : (Amendment) Bill 2014

: Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury

The debate on the Second Reading of the above Bill, which was moved on 2 July 2014, resumed. After Members and the public officer had respectively spoken, the President put the question on the Second Reading of the Bill, and the question was agreed to. The Bill was read the second time and committed to a committee of the whole Council.

The Council went into committee and considered the Bill. The question that clauses 1 to 6, 8, 9, 10, 12 to 21, 23, 24, 26 to 48, 50, 52, 53, 54, 56 and 57 stand part of the Bill was proposed, put and agreed to.

The question that clauses 7, 11, 22, 25, 49, 51 and 55 stand part of the Bill was proposed. The public officer moved amendments to clauses 7, 11, 22, 25, 49, 51 and 55 and spoke on the amendments. After Members had spoken, the Chairman ordered a separate vote on the amendment to clause 25 upon a Member's request.

The question on the amendments to clauses 7, 11, 22, 49, 51 and 55 was put and agreed to. The question that clauses 7, 11, 22, 49, 51 and 55 as amended stand part of the Bill was proposed, put and agreed to. The question on the amendment to clause 25 was put and agreed to (details of division in the **Appendix**). The question that clause 25 as amended stand part of the Bill was proposed, put and agreed to.

New clauses 26A, 27A and 58, and new part heading before new clause 58 were read the first time. The public officer moved the Second Reading of new clauses 26A, 27A and 58, and new part heading before new clause 58 and spoke on the new clauses. The Chairman proposed and put the question on the Second Reading of new clauses 26A, 27A and 58, and new part heading before new clause 58. The question was agreed to.

New clauses 26A, 27A and 58, and new part heading before new clause 58 were read the second time. The public officer moved the addition of new clauses 26A, 27A and 58, and new part heading before new clause 58 to the Bill. The question on the addition was proposed, put and agreed to.

The Council then resumed. The public officer reported that the Bill had passed through the Committee stage with amendments. The Bill was ordered to be set down for Third Reading under Rule 59 of the Rules of Procedure. The question on the Third Reading of the Bill was proposed, put and agreed to. The Bill was read the third time and passed.

Pharmacy and Poisons (Amendment) : Secretary for Food and Health
 Bill 2014

The debate on the Second Reading of the above Bill, which was moved on 26 March 2014, resumed. After Members and the public officer had respectively spoken, the President's Deputy put the question on the Second Reading of the Bill, and the question was agreed to. The Bill was read the second time and committed to a committee of the whole Council.

The Council went into committee and considered the Bill. The question that clauses 1 to 5, 8, 9, 11, 14, 16 to 19, 21, 22, 27, 28, 29, 31 to 42, 44, 45, 47, 48, 50, 51, 53, 54, 56, 57, 60, 61, 63, 64, 68, 69, 71 and 72 stand part of the Bill was proposed, put and agreed to.

The question that clauses 6, 7, 10, 12, 13, 15, 20, 23 to 26, 30, 43, 46, 49, 52, 55, 58, 59, 62, 65, 66, 67 and 70 stand part of the Bill was proposed. The public officer moved amendments to clauses 6, 7, 10, 12, 13, 15, 20, 23 to 26, 30, 43, 46, 49, 52, 55, 58, 59, 62, 65, 66, 67 and 70 and spoke on the amendments. The question on the amendments was put and agreed to. The question that clauses 6, 7, 10, 12, 13, 15, 20, 23 to 26, 30, 43, 46, 49, 52, 55, 58, 59, 62, 65, 66, 67 and 70 as amended stand part of the Bill was proposed, put and agreed to.

New clause 63A was read the first time. The public officer moved the Second Reading of new clause 63A and spoke on the new clause. The Chairman proposed and put the question on the Second Reading of new clause 63A. The question was agreed to.

New clause 63A was read the second time. The public officer moved the addition of new clause 63A to the Bill. The question on the addition was proposed, put and agreed to.

The question that the Schedule stand part of the Bill was proposed, put and agreed to.

The Council then resumed. The public officer reported that the Bill had passed through the Committee stage with amendments. The Bill was ordered to be set down for Third Reading under Rule 59 of the Rules of Procedure. The question on the Third Reading of the Bill was proposed, put and agreed to. The Bill was read the third time and passed.

Members' Motions

Motion under Rule 49E(2) of the Rules of Procedure

Hon Andrew LEUNG moved the motion as set out on the Agenda. The President proposed the question on the motion. Members and the public officer spoke respectively. In accordance with Rule 49E(9) of the Rules of Procedure, the President did not put the question on the motion.

Motion on "Combating insurance frauds"

(During the proceedings of this motion, the meeting was adjourned at 10:33 pm on 21 January 2015. The remaining proceedings of this motion were to be dealt with at the next Council meeting on 28 January 2015.)

Hon CHAN Kin-por moved the motion as set out on the Agenda. The President proposed the question on the motion and ordered a joint debate on the motion and the amendment. After the mover of the amendment, Members and the public officer had respectively spoken, the question on the amendment moved by Hon LEE Cheuk-yan was proposed and put. Hon LEE Cheuk-yan claimed a division. The President ordered the Council to proceed to a division.

After the division bell had been rung for five minutes, the President noted the absence of a quorum. He then directed the Members to be summoned.

Next meeting

After 15 minutes had expired, a quorum was not present. The President adjourned the Council in accordance with Rule 17(2) of the Rules of Procedure until 11:00 am on 28 January 2015.

The Council was adjourned at 10:33 pm.
