PHARMACY AND POISONS ORDINANCE

RESOLUTION

(Under section 29 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance (Cap. 138))

RESOLVED that -

- (a) the Pharmacy and Poisons (Amendment) Regulation 2002; and
- (b) the Poisons List (Amendment) Regulation 2002, made by the Pharmacy and Poisons Board on 8 March 2002 be approved

PHARMACY AND POISONS (AMENDMENT) REGULATION 2002

(Made by the Pharmacy and Poisons Board under section 29 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance (Cap. 138) subject to the approval of the Legislative Council)

1. Substances falling within the Poisons List to which special restrictions apply under regulations 3 and 5

The First Schedule to the Pharmacy and Poisons Regulations (Cap.

138 sub. leg.) is amended in part A -

- (a) in the item relating to "Alkaloids" -
 - (i) by repealing "Nicotine" and
 substituting -

"Nicotine, except chewing gum intended to be used in nicotine replacement therapy which contains not more than 2 mg of Nicotine per piece";

(ii) by adding -

"Galantamine";

(b) by adding -

"Eletriptan; its salts

Gatifloxacin; its salts; its esters

Imatinib; its salts

Tenecteplase; its salts

Tiagabine; its salts; its esters; their salts".

2. Substances required by regulation 9 to be sold by retail only upon a prescription given by a registered medical practitioner, registered dentist or registered veterinary surgeon

The Third Schedule is amended in part A -

- (b) by adding -

"Eletriptan; its salts

Gatifloxacin; its salts; its esters

Imatinib; its salts

Tenecteplase; its salts

Tiagabine; its salts; its esters; their salts".

Explanatory Note

This Regulation amends the First and Third Schedules to the Pharmacy and Poisons Regulations (Cap. 138 sub. leg.) -

POISONS LIST (AMENDMENT) REGULATION 2002

1. The Poisons List

The Schedule to the Poisons List Regulations (Cap. 138 sub. leg.) is amended -

- (a) in Part I, in part A -
 - (i) in the item relating to "Alkaloids" -
 - (A) by repealing "Nicotine" and substituting -

"Nicotine, except chewing gum intended to be used in nicotine replacement therapy which contains not more than 2 mg of Nicotine per piece";

(B) by adding -

"Galantamine";

(ii) by adding -

"Eletriptan; its salts

Gatifloxacin; its salts; its esters

Imatinib; its salts

Tenecteplase; its salts

Tiagabine; its salts; its esters; their

salts";

(b) in Part II, in part A, by adding -

"Nicotine: chewing gum intended to be used in nicotine replacement therapy which contains not more than 2 mg of Nicotine per piece".
