## Bills

## First Reading

## Broadcasting (Amendment) Bill 2003

The Bill was read the first time and ordered to be set down for Second Reading pursuant to Rule 53(3) of the Rules of Procedure.

## Second Reading

## Broadcasting (Amendment) Bill 2003

The Secretary for Commerce, Industry and Technology moved the Second Reading and addressed the Council.

Question on the Second Reading proposed. The President stated that in accordance with Rule  $54\,(4)$  of the Rules of Procedure, the debate was adjourned and the Bill was referred to the House Committee.

## Land (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Amendment) Bill 2002

## Resumption of Second Reading debate

The debate on the Second Reading which had been moved on 24 April 2002 resumed.

Hon LAU Ping-cheung, Chairman of the Bills Committee on Land (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Amendment) Bill 2002, addressed the Council on the Report of the Bills Committee on the Bill. After the address, he spoke on the Bill in his personal capacity as a Member.

Another five Members spoke on the Bill.

The Secretary for the Environment, Transport and Works replied.

Question on the Second Reading put and agreed to.

Bill read the second time and committed to a Committee of the whole Council.

### Committee Stage

The Council went into Committee and considered the Land (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Amendment) Bill 2002.

Question that clauses 5, 8, 10, 12 and 13 stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

Question that clauses 1 to 4, 6, 7, 9, 11, 14, 15 and 16 stand part of the Bill proposed.

The Secretary for the Environment, Transport and Works moved amendments to the aforesaid clauses and addressed the Committee.

Question on the amendments put and agreed to.

Question that clauses 1 to 4, 6, 7, 9, 11, 14, 15 and 16, as amended, stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

The Council then resumed.

## Third Reading

The Secretary for the Environment, Transport and Works reported that

the Land (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Amendment) Bill 2002

had passed through the Committee with amendments. She moved that the Bill be read the third time and do pass.

Question on the Third Reading proposed, put and agreed to.

Bill read the third time and passed.

#### Members' Motions

## Calling for the resignation of the Chief Executive, Mr TUNG Chee-hwa

Hon Albert CHAN moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council calls for the resignation of the Chief Executive, Mr TUNG Chee-hwa.

Question on the motion proposed.

The Chief Secretary for Administration, eight Members and Hon Albert HO spoke on the motion.

While Hon Albert HO was speaking, the President left the chair at 6:38 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Mrs Selina CHOW, took the chair.

Another five Members and Hon YEUNG Yiu-chung spoke on the motion.

At 7:16 pm, while Hon YEUNG Yiu-chung was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

12 more Members and Hon Michael MAK spoke on the motion.

While Hon Michael MAK was speaking, Hon TAM Yiu-chung raised a point of order on whether Hon Michael MAK had breached the Rules of Procedure by displaying an exhibit. The President stated that she had not intervened as the contents of Hon Michael MAK's speech related to the cardboard he was holding.

Another 10 Members, the Secretary for Justice and the Secretary for Constitutional Affairs spoke on the motion.

The Chief Secretary for Administration spoke on the motion the second time.

Hon Albert CHAN replied.

Question on the motion put.

Hon Albert CHAN claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 29 were present, five were in favour of the motion and 24 against it; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct

elections and by the Election Committee, 26 were present, 14 were in favour of the motion and 11 against it. (Voting record in the Appendix.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the motion was negatived.

# Exploring new areas of co-operation between Hong Kong and Guangdong

Hon Ambrose LAU moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That, as the Chief Executive has stated in this year's Policy Address that Hong Kong and Guangdong should, with the common goal of achieving a major modernised economic region, raise and speed up the level of co-operation in exploring new areas of common interests where there is room for enhanced co-operation, this Council urges the Government to actively consult various industrial, commercial and professional sectors on the relevant subjects and expeditiously put forward feasible proposals and implementation timetables.

Question on the motion proposed.

10 Members and the Chief Secretary for Administration spoke on the motion.

Hon Ambrose LAU replied.

Question on the motion put and agreed to.

The President declared that the next meeting of the Council would be held on 15 May 2003 at 3:00 pm.
