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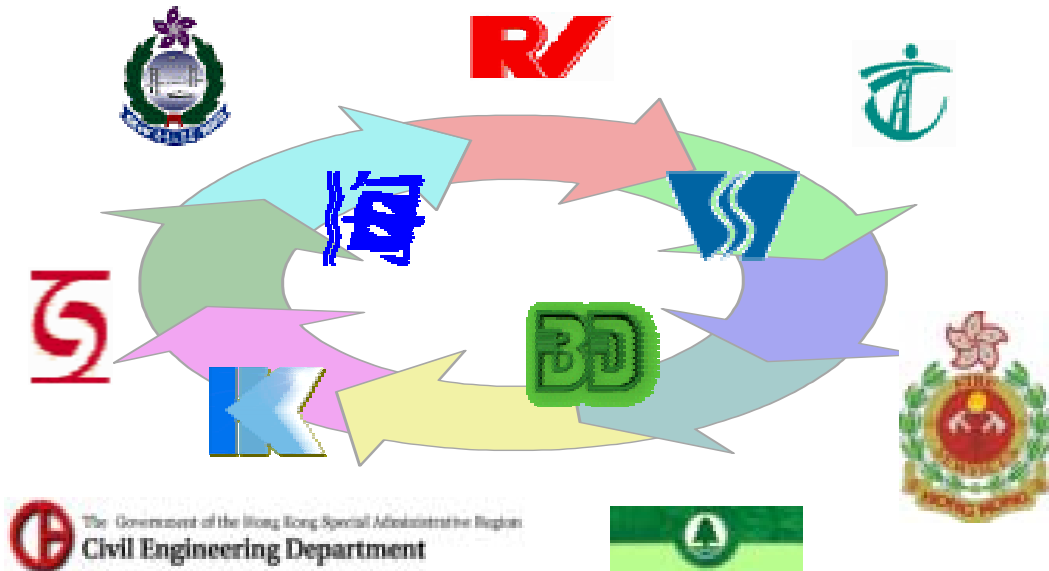

## How will an IF help ?



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## What is the IF ?

- r Technical specifications and data specifications for use at the interface between interacting applications
- r Adoption of eXtensible Markup Language (XML) for information exchange
- r Defines the way for B/Ds to do e-business
- r No binding on interactions among members of the public

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## Similar initiatives in other economies



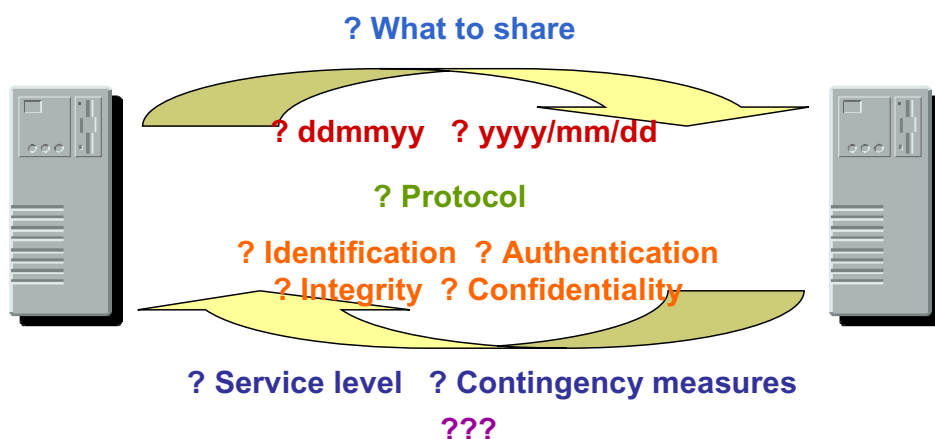
- r UK's e-GIF (first issued in October 2000)
- r New Zealand's e-GIF (first issued in July 2002)
- r Australia issued their draft framework in May 2002
- r US CIO Council formed an XML Working Group in 2000 to develop XML adoption strategies
- r US GAO recommended more central co-ordination to facilitate the effective use of XML among agencies

### A lot of issues need to be aligned

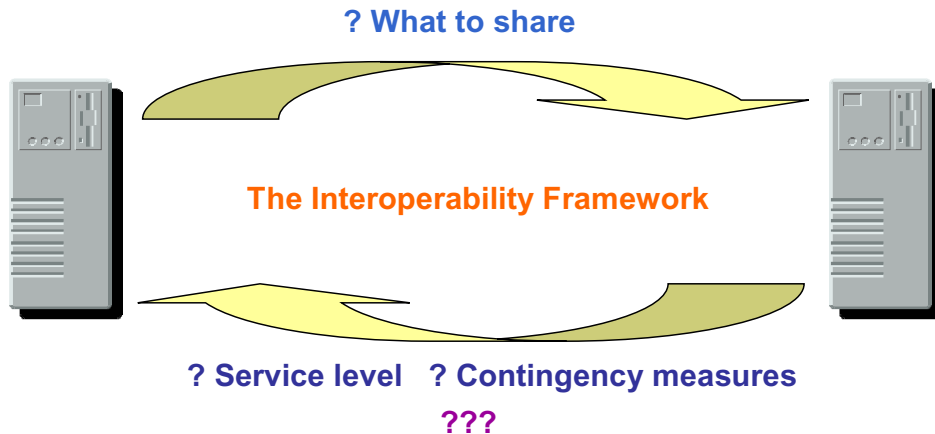


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## Before two parties can share information - with the IF

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## Benefits the IF can bring



- r To E-government
  - q help speed up the development of joined-up services
  - q help lower the cost of implementing joined-up services
- r To the public
  - q more efficient services to citizens and businesses
  - q help improve our overall competitiveness
- r To the IT industry
  - q complement e-business standardization initiatives in the private sector

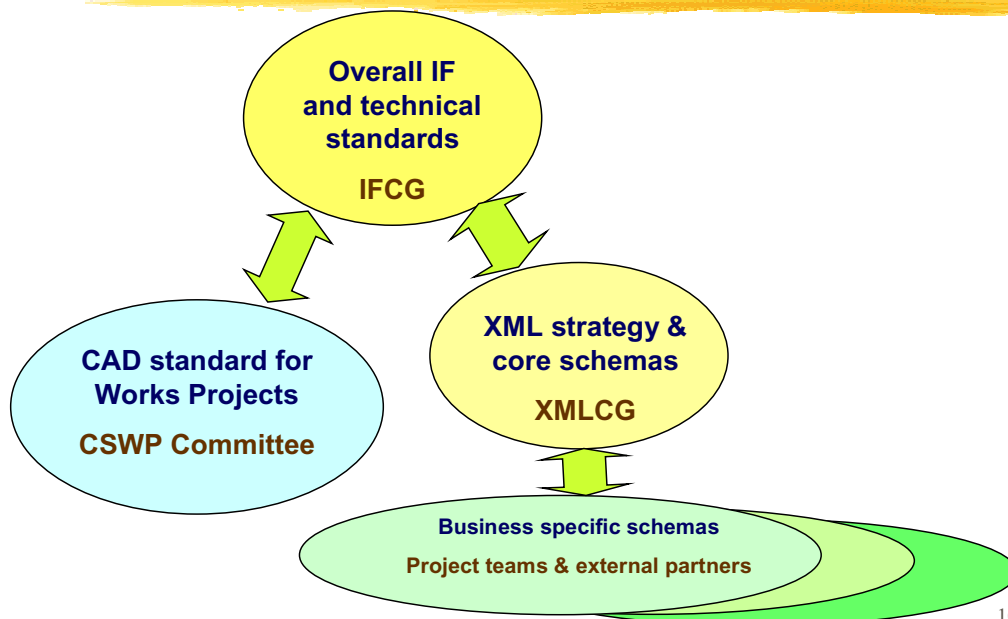
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## Establishment of the IF

- r Consultation undertaken
  - q widely consulted B/Ds, the IT industry, and the public
  - q briefed the IIAC at various stages
  - q various parties indicated strong support
  
- r Promulgation of the IF
  - q promulgated to B/Ds in Nov
  - q SCIT will issue gazette notices to promulgate additional formats relevant for electronic submissions under the ETO

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## Parties managing the IF



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## Maintenance and management of the IF



- r Review the IF every 6 to 12 months
- r The IF will yield best results only if the stakeholders (B/Ds and the IT industry) use it
- r Must be pragmatic & addresses (and balances) the needs of the stakeholders
- r Stakeholders have access to the IF documents
- r Stakeholders may request changes at any time

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## Some challenges of implementing joined-up services



- r Business partners have to go through tedious data alignment before they can connect their applications
- r Problems : they have
  - q different business vocabulary
  - q different data attributes
- r Without an agreed convention, such alignment have to be repeated for each joined-up initiative

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## Handling these challenges

- r Follow pre-agreed XML schema design guidelines
- r Re-use pre-agreed schemas for common data items
- r Put in place a mechanism for schema maintenance
- r Design project schemas with re-use in mind
- r Share schemas through a registry

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## Work plan for 2003



- q Produce XML schema design and management guidelines
- q Progressively define core schemas
- q Facilitate schema sharing through a registry
- q Continue to review & update the IF
