Information provided in response to letter dated 19 April from the Clerk to Select Committee to inquire into the handling of the Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome outbreak by the Government and the Hospital Authority

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Concerning the personal protective equipment (PPE) donated by the Central Government during the SARS outbreak -

(a) whether the Administration had communicated with the Central Government on the specification requirements of the PPE in need before the donations were made; if yes, what were the requirements?

The Administration had provided the Mainland authorities with information on the specification requirements and samples of the PPE in need. The detailed specification requirements are set out in the Appendix.

## (b) what were the types and quantities of the PPE delivered;

The PPE supplies donated by the Central People's Government (CPG) were delivered to the Hospital Authority (HA) between 8 and 29 May 2003 in three batches. The types and quantities of PPE delivered are tabulated as follows –

## (c) the use and applicability of the PPE delivered; and

All the PPE items delivered complied with the specified requirements. On receipt, the HA Head Office determined the allocation of the PPE donated by CPG at the hospital cluster level having regard to the stock position of individual hospital clusters. On receipt of the PPE supplies, the clusters distributed them to their hospitals to meet operational requirements. HA also provided Barrier Man to different government departments such as the Electrical and Mechanical Services Department, Fire Services Department, Food and Environmental Hygiene Department, Department of Health, Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department and Government Logistics Department to help combat possible outbreak of SARS and avian flu etc.

(d) what is the stock position of the PPE donated by the Central Government as of today.

All the PPE supplies donated by CPG have been fully consumed with the exception of Barrier Man. As at April 2004, there is a remaining stock of 13,325 pieces of Barrier Man which are kept in the HA Head Office store as contingency stock.

# Appendix

# Specification requirements of PPE

## (A) Goggles

### Material requirements

- made of plastic, light and comfortable
- with anti-fog coating

### Design

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- lenses should resist scratching during normal use
- goggles should be comfortable for extended periods of wear
- should provide excellent panoramic vision
- · can be disinfected with disinfectant

### (B) N95

According to the NIOSH recommendation, the respirator shall have a bacteria filtration efficiency (BFE) of not less than 95 percent efficiency with mean particle size of 0.3micron.

# (C) Surgical Filter Mask (Ear-loop or Tie-on) (See Annex A)

3-ply non-woven fabric. The mask shall have a bacteria filtration efficiency (BFE) of not less than 95 percent efficiency with mean particle size of 3micron.

### (D) Face Shield

### Material requirements

- · should be made of optical grade film with anti-fog coating
- 33cm in width x 22 cm in length ±10%

### Design

- light, comfortable and provides panoramic vision
- full face coverage
- can fit over spectacle
- should have a soft forehead band and stretch comfort band for secure fit

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### (E) Disposable Isolation Gown

### Material requirements

- spun bonded polypropylene
- latex free
- weighing less that 30gm/m<sup>2</sup>

### Design

- elastic cuff
- black closures: The top one (neck) and waist should be closed by ties for secure coverage
- water repellent

# (F) Disposable Examination Gloves (See Annex B)

## Material requirement

hypo allergic latex

### Design

- cuff length: approximately 6-7cm
- thickness: 0.15mm
- powdered: hypoallergic powder for easing donning
- free from holes
- comes in different sizes

# Specification for Supply of Surgical Filter Mask, Tie-on

### M: Mandatory Requirement

The product offered shall incorporate the following components / requirements / features.

### 1. General Description

A high filtration mask suitable for maintaining protective asoptic techniques within surgical suites/other specialties and providing a snug fit to the contours of the face of wearer.

### 2. Function


- 2.1 The mask shall has the effectiveness of the mask material (filter media plus facings) to filter bacteria.
- 2.2 It shall has the effectiveness of the mask as entity when used on the face of wearer.

### 3. Configurations (Tolerance of ±10% could be allowed)

- 3.1 Design;
  - 3.1.1 The mask shall consist of a filter mat encased and bounded in two soft layers of 3-ply non-woven fabrics making a perfect 3-fold pleats lengthways (Figure a).
  - 3.1.2 A nose piece of malleable aluminum strip 135mm (L) x 3mm (W) (Figure b) should be provided to afford maximum comfort, case of breathing and maintaining the contours of the nose of wearer.
  - 3.1.3 The material of mask should be durable to prevent the malleable aluminum strip from protruding out easily.


