

## Select Committee to inquire into the handling of the Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome Outbreak by the Government and the Hospital Authority

I refer to your letter dated 17th June 2004. My response to the two questions raised in your letter is as follows:-

- 1. I chaired the meeting in the late afternoon of 10th March 2003 to review the situation of Ward 8A in the Prince of Wales Hospital.
