1. The acute general hospitals should NOT be the SRS Hospitals
2. The SARS Hospitals should be up-graded with facilities:
 - a. ICU/HDU
 - b. Radiological & laboratory services
 - c. Staff accommodation facilities
3. Patients with suspected SRS should be kept away from hospital. They should be nursed at home or "hostel" facilities with medical support and supervision.
4. The role of the private general practitioner and Department of Health as the 1st line of defence should be well coordinated
