Admission of severe CAP cases

Thank you for helping out. I would be most grateful if your colleagues can indicate to the admission office for severe Community Acquired Pneumonia (CAP) cases. Such an alert mechanism will be activated using the following set of criteria:

Severe CAP cases requiring ventilation (i.e. intubation) or CAP cases under ICU care.

Severe CAP with history of travel to China, or history of exposure to persons with severe pneumonia who had been in China, or

3. Severe CAP cases with exposure to poultry

These criteria are adopted from HAHO's guidelines. Within M&O there will a mechanism to place these patients into isolation facilities available. I am also establishing a hospital-wide mechanism should M&G's isolation facilities are full.
