Q. Any report(s) or relevant record(s) available on confirmed / suspected cases of SARS as a result of visiting hospitals during SARS outbreak.

The following table sets out the few patients who were later confirmed to have SARS after visiting a hospital. However, it should be pointed out that it does not follow that they contracted SARS while visiting a hospital - there was no confirmation of such link.
