## I. Confirmation of minutes

The minutes of the meeting held on 2 May 2006 were confirmed.

## **II.** Meeting with the Administration

[LC Paper No. CB(2)222/05-06(03)]

2. The Bills Committee discussed issues relating to termination of managers, procurement by owners' corporations (OCs) and managers, accounts of corporations, meeting and procedure of corporation, financial arrangements for OCs and managers, mandatory terms in deed of mutual covenants (DMCs), delegation of powers and duties by the Secretary for Home Affairs, and voting rights of non-paying owners in the paper entitled "The Administration's response to views of the professional bodies in the building management sector". (Index of proceedings is at **Annex**).

Applicability of the Seventh and the Eighth Schedules to the Building Management Ordinance (BMO) to sub-deeds of mutual covenant (sub-DMCs)

# Admin 3. <u>The Administration</u> was requested to –

(a) provide relevant documents to support that all sub-DMCs were required to be endorsed by the Lands Department (LD) in accordance with the LD's guidelines on DMCs;

Action

- (b) confirm whether all sub-DMCs were subject to the LD's endorsement even though a Certificate of Compliance had been issued to the building/development concerned; and
- (c) explain the termination mechanism of building managers appointed under those sub-DMCs which had been made before the issue of the LD's guidelines on DMC and did not stipulate such a mechanism.
- 4. <u>Mr Albert CHAN</u> suggested that to facilitate members' consideration of the issue, the Administration should provide information setting out the various types of sub-DMCs and the respective termination mechanisms of sub-DMC building managers.

# Accounts of corporations

- 5. <u>The Administration</u> was requested to consider the following suggestions
  - (a) owners should be allowed under BMO to inspect all bills, invoices, vouchers, receipts and other documents kept by an management committee (MC) as required by paragraph 1 in the Sixth Schedule to BMO; and
  - (b) MCs should be required under BMO to display summaries of the income and expenditure of the corporation in a prominent place in the building for one week.

## Procurement of third party risks insurance

6. At the suggestion of the Chairman, <u>members</u> agreed that the Bills Committee should discuss issues relating to the procurement of third party risks insurance for OCs at a future meeting and members should be notified in advance.

#### Voting rights of non-paying owners

7. The Chairman and Ms Miriam LAU were of the view that non-paying owners should be disallowed to vote at any meetings of OCs or of owners by incorporating appropriate provisions in BMO, or by passing a resolution at an owners' meeting to such effect. Miss CHOY So-yuk considered that a credit period should be allowed, and non-paying owners' right of voting for appointment of members of MC should not be affected. Mr Jasper TSANG, however, expressed reservations about the proposal as it might infringe property rights of the owners concerned. The Administration was requested to consider the views expressed by members.
