First Reading

Revenue Bill 2007 Revenue (No. 2) Bill 2007

The Bills were read the first time and ordered to be set down for Second Reading pursuant to Rule 53(3) of the Rules of Procedure.

Second Reading

Revenue Bill 2007
Revenue (No. 2) Bill 2007

The Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury moved the Second Reading of each of the above two Bills and addressed the Council thereon.

Question on the Second Reading proposed. The President stated that in accordance with Rule 54(4) of the Rules of Procedure, the debates on the above Bills were adjourned and the Bills were referred to the House Committee.

Accreditation of Academic and Vocational Qualifications Bill

Resumption of Second Reading debate

The debate on the Second Reading which was moved on 6 July 2005 resumed.

Hon TAM Yiu-chung, Chairman of the Bills Committee on Accreditation of Academic and Vocational Qualifications Bill, addressed the Council on the Committee's Report. After the address, he spoke on the Bill in his personal capacity as a Member.

While Hon TAM Yiu-chung was speaking, the President left the chair at 1:18 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

Five Members and Hon Margaret NG spoke on the Bill.

At 2:46 pm, while Hon Margaret NG was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Six other Members spoke on the Bill.

The Secretary for Education and Manpower replied.

Question on the Second Reading put and agreed to.

Bill read the second time and committed to a Committee of the whole Council.

Committee Stage

The Council went into Committee and considered the Accreditation of Academic and Vocational Qualifications Bill.

Question that clauses 1, 6, 15, 16, 17, 24, 27 to 33, 36, 37, 40 to 43 and 46 stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

Question that clauses 2 to 5, 7 and 8, Part 3, clauses 13, 14, 18 to 23, 25, 26, 34, 35, 38, 39, 44, 45, 47 and 48 stand part of the Bill proposed.

The Secretary for Education and Manpower moved amendments to the aforesaid clauses and addressed the Committee.

Question on the amendments put and agreed to.

Question that clauses 2 to 5, 7 and 8, Part 3, clauses 13, 14, 18 to 23, 25, 26, 34, 35, 38, 39, 44, 45, 47 and 48, as amended, stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

Question that schedule 2 stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

Question that schedules 1 and 3 stand part of the Bill proposed.

The Secretary for Education and Manpower moved amendments to the aforesaid schedules and addressed the Committee.

Question on the amendments put and agreed to.

Question that schedules 1 and 3, as amended, stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

Question that the enacting formula stand part of the Bill proposed.

The Secretary for Education and Manpower moved an amendment to the enacting formula and addressed the Committee.

Question on the amendment put and agreed to.

The Council then resumed.

Third Reading

The Secretary for Education and Manpower reported that

the Accreditation of Academic and Vocational Qualifications Bill

had passed through the Committee with amendments. He moved that the Bill be read the third time and do pass.

Question on the Third Reading proposed, put and agreed to.

Bill read the third time and passed.

Employment (Amendment) Bill 2006

Resumption of Second Reading debate

The debate on the Second Reading which was moved on 20 December 2006 resumed.

Hon KWONG Chi-kin, Chairman of the Bills Committee on Employment (Amendment) Bill 2006, addressed the Council on the Committee's Report.

Six Members spoke on the Bill.

The Secretary for Economic Development and Labour replied.

Question on the Second Reading put.

Hon James TIEN claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to proceed to a division under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that 43 Members were present, 36 were in favour of the motion, one against it and five abstained. (Voting record in Appendix I.) Since the question was agreed by a majority of the Members present, she declared that the motion was carried.

Bill read the second time and committed to a Committee of the whole Council.

Committee Stage

The Council went into Committee and considered the **Employment** (Amendment) Bill 2006.

Question that clauses 1, 2, 4, 11, 13 and 15 stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

Question that clauses 3, 5 to 10, 12, 14 and 16 stand part of the Bill proposed.

The Secretary for Economic Development and Labour moved amendments to the aforesaid clauses and addressed the Committee.

Question on the amendments put and agreed to.

Question that clauses 3, 5 to 10, 12, 14 and 16, as amended, stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

New clause 15A read the first time.

The Secretary for Economic Development and Labour moved the Second Reading of new clause 15A and addressed the Committee.

Question on the Second Reading of new clause 15A proposed, put and agreed to.

New clause 15A read the second time.

The Secretary for Economic Development and Labour moved the addition of new clause 15A to the Bill.

Question on the addition proposed, put and agreed to.

The Council then resumed.

Third Reading

The Secretary for Economic Development and Labour reported that

the Employment (Amendment) Bill 2006

had passed through the Committee with amendments. He moved that the Bill be read the third time and do pass.

Question on the Third Reading proposed and put.

Hon Andrew LEUNG Kwan-yuen claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to proceed to a division under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that 42 Members were present, 35 were in favour of the motion and six against it. (Voting record in Appendix II.) Since the question was agreed by a majority of the Members present, she declared that the motion was carried.

Bill read the third time and passed.

Motions

Proposed resolution under the Legal Aid Ordinance

The Chief Secretary for Administration moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

RESOLVED -

- (a) that the Legal Aid Ordinance (Cap. 91) be amended -
 - (i) in section 5(1), by repealing "\$158,300" and substituting "\$162,300";

- (ii) in section 5A(b) -
 - (A) by repealing "\$158,300" and substituting "\$162,300";
 - (B) by repealing "\$439,800" and substituting "\$450,800"; and
- (b) that this Resolution shall come into operation on a day to be appointed by the Director of Administration by notice published in the Gazette.

Question on the motion proposed.

Three Members spoke on the motion.

The Chief Secretary for Administration replied.

Question on the motion put and agreed to.

Members' Motions

Increasing the number of local university places

Hon CHEUNG Man-kwong moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council urges the Government to increase the annual quota of 14 500 publicly-funded university places so as to provide more opportunities for local young people in the appropriate age group to attend universities, and to open up more channels for outstanding graduates of sub-degree courses to pursue further studies, in order to cater for the needs of the local community and education development.

While Hon CHEUNG Man-kwong was addressing the Council, the President left the chair at 6:13 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

Question on Hon CHEUNG Man-kwong's motion proposed.

The President's Deputy stated that Hon Andrew LEUNG Kwan-yuen would move an amendment to the motion. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion and the amendment would be debated together in a joint debate.

Hon Andrew LEUNG Kwan-yuen moved the following amendment to Hon CHEUNG Man-kwong's motion and addressed the Council:

To delete "the annual quota of 14 500 publicly-funded" after "urges the Government to increase"; to add "across the board, including those of publicly-funded and private universities," after "university places"; to delete "to open" after "attend universities, and" and substitute with "in addition to opening"; and to delete "in order to cater for the needs of the local community and education development" after "further studies," and substitute with "provide opportunities to more non-local students to attend universities in Hong Kong, so as to facilitate Hong Kong's development into an education hub of the region and cater for the social, education and economic development needs of Hong Kong, and to enable Hong Kong's human resources development to better tie in with the National Eleventh Five-Year Plan and subsequent plans in the Mainland, thereby training more talents in various sectors such as finance, trade, logistics, tourism and culture for Hong Kong".

Question on Hon Andrew LEUNG Kwan-yuen's amendment to Hon CHEUNG Man-kwong's motion proposed.

After declaring his interest as the President Professor of the nursing programme team of the Open University of Hong Kong, Dr Hon Joseph LEE Kok-long spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Four other Members spoke on the motion and the amendment.

After declaring his interest as a teacher in the Hong Kong Polytechnic University, Dr Hon Fernando CHEUNG spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Another four Members and Hon Selina CHOW spoke on the motion and the amendment.

At 7:44 pm, while Hon Selina CHOW was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Two more Members spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Hon CHEUNG Man-kwong spoke on the amendment.

The Secretary for Education and Manpower spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Question on Hon Andrew LEUNG Kwan-yuen's amendment to Hon CHEUNG Man-kwong's motion put and agreed to.

Hon CHEUNG Man-kwong replied.

Question on Hon CHEUNG Man-kwong's motion as amended by Hon Andrew LEUNG Kwan-yuen put and agreed to.

Conserving the Queen's Pier

Hon Alan LEONG Kah-kit moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That, given the grave concerns expressed by various sectors of the community about the preservation of the Queen's Pier in Central, and for the effective conservation of the Queen's Pier, this Council urges the Government to immediately adopt the Principles for the Conservation of Heritage Sites in China approved by the Central People's Government in 2000 and to to "conservation undertake adopt in-situ, minimal interference, preservation of the original condition and protection of the heritage environment" as the principles for formulating and expeditiously implementing the most effective proposal for preserving the Queen's Pier in-situ, including proper adjustments to the current works projects and designs of future projects to avoid damaging the existing structure of the Queen's Pier, so as to minimize the impact of works projects on the present site of the Queen's Pier.

Question on Hon Alan LEONG Kah-kit's motion proposed.

The President stated that two Members would move amendments to the motion. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion and the two amendments would be debated together in a joint debate.

Hon Mrs Selina CHOW and Hon CHEUNG Hok-ming, who would move amendments to the motion, spoke on the motion and their own amendments.

16 other Members spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Hon Alan LEONG Kah-kit spoke on the amendments.

The Secretary for Housing, Planning and Lands spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Hon Mrs Selina CHOW moved the following amendment to Hon Alan LEONG Kah-kit's motion:

To add "recently" after "grave concerns expressed"; to delete ", and for the effective conservation of" after "the Queen's Pier in Central" and substitute with "and their discussion on the four proposals put forth by the Government for dealing with"; to delete "adopt" after "immediately" and substitute with "make reference to"; to delete "and to undertake to adopt 'conservation in-situ, minimal interference, preservation of the original condition and protection of the heritage environment' as the principles for formulating" after "in 2000" and substitute with "to formulate"; to delete "implementing" after "expeditiously" and substitute with "implement"; to add "reasonable, practical and" after "the most"; to delete "in-situ, including proper adjustments to the current works projects and designs of future projects to avoid damaging the existing structure of the Queen's Pier" "preserving the Queen's Pier"; and to delete "of projects on the present site of the Queen's Pier" "minimize the impact" and substitute with "on the Central Reclamation Phase III works which are underway, and to commence as soon as possible discussion involving public participation on the site and design concept for the relocation of the Queen's Pier".

Question on Hon Mrs Selina CHOW's amendment to Hon Alan LEONG Kah-kit's motion proposed and put.

Hon Alan LEONG Kah-kit claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to proceed to a division under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 24 were present, 17 were in favour of the amendment and seven against it; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 23 were present, eight were in favour of the amendment and 14 against it. (Voting record in Appendix III.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon CHEUNG Hok-ming moved the following amendment to Hon Alan LEONG Kah-kit's motion:

"immediately adopt the Principles delete Conservation of Heritage Sites in China approved by the Central People's Government in 2000 and to undertake to adopt 'conservation in-situ, minimal interference, preservation of condition and protection of the heritage original environment' as the principles for formulating" after "urges the Government to" and substitute with ", under the principle striking a proper balance between the conservation of valuable buildings and urban development, formulate"; to delete "implementing" after "expeditiously" and substitute "implement"; and to delete ", including adjustments to the current works projects and designs of future projects to avoid damaging the existing structure of the Queen's Pier, so as to minimize the impact of works projects on the present site of the Queen's Pier" after "insitu" and substitute with "or nearby, so as to facilitate the community's sustainable and balanced development".

Question on Hon CHEUNG Hok-ming's amendment to Hon Alan LEONG Kah-kit's motion proposed and put.

Hon Alan LEONG Kah-kit claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to proceed to a division under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 24 were present, 10 were in favour of the amendment, 13 against it and one abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 23 were present, six were in favour of the amendment and 16 against it. (Voting record in Appendix IV.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon Alan LEONG Kah-kit replied.

Question on Hon Alan LEONG Kah-kit's motion put.

Hon CHAN Kam-lam claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to proceed to a division under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 24 were present, six were in favour of the motion, 16 against it and two abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 23 were present, 14 were in favour of the motion and eight against it. (Voting record in Appendix V.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the motion was negatived.

Next Meeting
