


Give vendors a chance in WKNC

At the time the WKCD by-laws are set up, we urge the legislature to add a exemption that mobile vendors and hawkers are allowed to practice their own business without advanced permission at all times the WKCD opened to public.

As far as I know, the hawkers have little chance in obtaining a legal permit and freedom of business. Moreover, many conflicts during enforcement have shown that the government is not only ~~reluctant~~ reluctant in opening gateway in vendors, but also stand against our commons upon favouring Chinese tourists. Especially in the enhanced conflicts unfold in Mong Kok & Tuen Mun, the action of vendor policies allows NO procrastination for legislation.

In the light of commencement of «West Kowloon Culture District By-laws», I hope the WKCD authority widen the restriction of vendors' activity within the area concerned without selection or permission in advance so that Hong Kong economy and metropolitan culture can be revitalised in the WKCD during the repression days of Hong Kong Economy. Any municipal services (especially FEHD) should make LITTLE intervention in this area.
