Debate and voting arrangements

Object of the proposed resolution by the Secretary for the Environment ("SEN"): To provide for the necessary operational details for the implementation of the producer responsibility scheme on waste electrical and electronic equipment (covering eight classes of electrical and electronic equipment, i.e. air conditioners, refrigerators, washing machines, televisions, computers, printers, scanners and monitors (collectively referred to as "REE")) under the Product Eco-responsibility (Regulated Electrical Equipment) Regulation ("the Regulation").

Hon HUI Chi-fung

1st amending motion

- To amend section 9(3) of the Regulation to "require" registered suppliers to affix recycling labels onto REE distributed by them (according to SEN's proposed resolution, such supplier "may" provide the label by affixing it to REE), and to make a corresponding amendment by deleting section 27(3) of the Regulation.

2nd amending motion

- To amend section 40 of the Regulation on the timeframe for the provision of a removal service for REE to enable a consumer to decide whether to request a removal service after the distribution transaction has been entered into and no later than the time at which the consumer takes actual possession of the new REE.
