Legislative Council Establishment Subcommittee Follow-up to Meeting on 6 June 2017 EC(2017-18)1

At the meeting on 6 June 2017, Members of the Establishment Subcommittee requested the Government to provide the amount of donation received by the Community Care Fund (CCF) annually and the main source of donation since its establishment; and the details of 11 assistance programmes which were previously implemented by the CCF and have been incorporated into the Government's regular assistance programmes.
