Report No. 10/16-17 of the House Committee on Consideration of Subsidiary Legislation and Other Instruments

Purpose

This report gives the outcome of the consideration of the House Committee on subsidiary legislation the period for amendment of which will expire at the Council meeting of 8 February 2017.

2. The House Committee has considered the following items of subsidiary legislation:

3. The House Committee formed three subcommittees to study item (1), items (2) and (3), as well as items (4) and (5) respectively in detail at its meetings on 9 and 16 December 2016. The three Subcommittees reported their deliberations at the House Committee meeting on 20 January 2017 vide LC Paper Nos. CB(4)436/16-17, CB(4)446/16-17 and CB(1)428/16-17 respectively.

4. In respect of item (6), the House Committee considered it not necessary to form a subcommittee to study this item of subsidiary legislation.

Note: The House Committee formed a subcommittee to study the following two items of subsidiary legislation at its meeting on 6 January 2017. The President has given permission for Hon CHAN Chun-ying, Chairman of the Subcommittee, to move a proposed resolution at the Council meeting of 8 February 2017 to extend the period for amending these two items of subsidiary legislation to the Council meeting of 1 March 2017.
