

**Pharmacy and Poisons (Amendment) (No. 5) Regulation 2017**

**(“the Amendment Regulation”)**

**Debate and voting arrangements**

**Object of the Amendment Regulation** : To amend the Pharmacy and Poisons Regulations (Cap. 138A) by adding Netupitant and its salts (“the relevant substance”) to Schedules 1, 3 and 10 (Poisons List) to Cap. 138A.

The effect of the above amendments is that the relevant substance is subject to restrictions concerning its sale, supply, labelling and storage, and can only be sold by retail upon a prescription given by a registered medical practitioner, registered dentist or registered veterinary surgeon. Further, the relevant substance can only be sold on registered premises of an authorized seller of poisons by a registered pharmacist or in the presence and under the supervision of a registered pharmacist.
