## Pharmacy and Poisons (Amendment) (No. 5) Regulation 2017 ("the Amendment Regulation") Debate and voting arrangements

Object of the<br/>Amendment: To amend the Pharmacy and Poisons Regulations<br/>(Cap. 138A) by adding Netupitant and its salts ("the relevant<br/>substance") to Schedules 1, 3 and 10 (Poisons List) to<br/>Cap. 138A.

The effect of the above amendments is that the relevant substance is subject to restrictions concerning its sale, supply, labelling and storage, and can only be sold by retail upon a prescription given by a registered medical practitioner, registered dentist or registered veterinary surgeon. Further, the relevant substance can only be sold on registered premises of an authorized seller of poisons by a registered pharmacist or in the presence and under the supervision of a registered pharmacist.
