Explanatory Note

The Hazardous Chemicals Control Ordinance (Cap. 595) (***Ordinance***) regulates the manufacture, export, import and use of certain hazardous chemicals. These chemicals are specified in Schedules 1 and 2 to the Ordinance, and include those subject to the regulation of the Rotterdam Convention on the Prior Informed Consent Procedure for Certain Hazardous Chemicals and Pesticides in International Trade (***Rotterdam Convention***).

2. The list of chemicals subject to the regulation of the Rotterdam Convention has been amended. Correspondingly, this Order amends Schedule 2 to the Ordinance to update the list of chemicals regulated by the Ordinance.
