Amendments to be moved by the Secretary for Food and Health

<u>Clause</u>	<u>Amendment Proposed</u>
15(3)(b)	By adding “reasonably” after “use”.
31	By adding— “(5) A person is taken to have established a fact that needs to be established for a defence under subsection (4) if— (a) there is sufficient evidence to raise an issue with respect to the fact; and (b) the contrary is not proved by the prosecution beyond reasonable doubt.”.
32	By renumbering the clause as clause 32(1).
32	By adding— “(2) An employee is taken to have established a fact that needs to be established for a defence under subsection (1) if— (a) there is sufficient evidence to raise an issue with respect to the fact; and (b) the contrary is not proved by the prosecution beyond reasonable doubt.”.
