- (b) (i) the specific measures to be implemented by the Administration in collaboration with The University of Hong Kong ("the University") to facilitate public access to the three Grade 1 historic buildings of the University, namely Fung Ping Shan Building, Eliot Hall and May Hall, which are declared to be historical buildings under the Antiquities and Monuments (Declaration of Monuments and Historical Buildings) (Consolidation) (Amendment) Notice 2018, and to increase awareness, understanding and appreciation of the cultural heritage of these buildings; (ii) the estimated costs of these measures and (iii) whether and how the Administration will provide financial or other assistance for implementing the measures.
