**Heung Yuen Wai Boundary Control Point Closed Area
(Permission to Enter) Notice**

(Made by the Commissioner of Police under section 38A of the Public Order Ordinance (Cap. 245))

1. Commencement

This Notice comes into operation on the day on which the Closed Area (Heung Yuen Wai Boundary Control Point) Order comes into operation.

2. Interpretation

In this Notice—

Closed Area (禁區) means the area declared to be a closed area under section 3 of the Closed Area Order;

Closed Area Order (《禁區令》) means the Closed Area (Heung Yuen Wai Boundary Control Point) Order.

3. Permission to enter or leave

Without affecting any other Ordinance, a person of a category specified in column 2 of Part 2 of the Schedule is permitted to enter or leave the Closed Area at any time subject to all of the conditions specified in column 3 of that Part that are applicable to the person of that category.

Part 1

Interpretation

1. Interpretation

In this Schedule—

cross-boundary (跨境) means travelling to or from the Mainland of China;

Drop-off Area (落客區) means the cross-boundary coach drop-off area located at Heung Yuen Wai Boundary Control Point;

Heung Yuen Wai Boundary Control Point (香園圍邊境管制站) has the meaning given by section 2 of the Closed Area Order;

Passenger Terminal Building (旅檢大樓) means the part of the Passenger Terminal Building located at Heung Yuen Wai Boundary Control Point that is part of the Closed Area;

Pick-up Area (上客區) means the cross-boundary coach pick-up area located at Heung Yuen Wai Boundary Control Point.
