## **Explanatory Note**

This Regulation makes amendments to the Merchant Shipping (Seafarers) (Official Log Books) (Amendment) Regulation 2016 (L.N. 75 of 2016) which are consequential to the making of the Merchant Shipping (Safety) (Navigational Equipment and Safety of Navigation) Regulation (Cap. 369 sub. leg. BA) (*Safety Regulation*). In particular, the amendments aim to—

- (a) include the reference to the Safety Regulation in the Merchant Shipping (Seafarers) (Official Log Books) Regulation (Cap. 478 sub. leg. P); and
- (b) remove the reference to the Merchant Shipping (Safety) (Arrangements for Embarkation and Disembarkation of Pilots) Regulation (Cap. 369 sub. leg. AU), which had been repealed in view of the making of the Safety Regulation.
