**Minutes of the meeting held on Wednesday 27 November 2019 at 11:00 am
and Thursday 28 November 2019 at 9:00 am**

Attendance

The attendance of Members, public officers and Clerks is in the Official Record of Proceedings.

Papers laid on the Table of the Council

Three items of subsidiary legislation/instruments and seven other papers laid on the Table of the Council under Rule 21(2) of the Rules of Procedure (“RoP”) were in **Appendix 1**.

Questions

Six oral questions (i.e. Questions 1 to 6) were put by the Members, and oral replies given by the public officers to the main and supplementary questions put by Members.

Written replies to Questions 7 to 22 were supplied to Members.

Government Bills

First Reading and Second Reading (debate to be adjourned)

- Copyright (Amendment) Bill 2019 : Secretary for Commerce and Economic Development
- Road Traffic Legislation (Parking Spaces) : Secretary for Transport and (Amendment) Bill 2019 Housing

After the Bills were read the first time and ordered to be set down for Second Reading under RoP 53(3), the public officers moved the Second Reading of the Bills respectively. The questions on the Second Reading of the Bills were proposed respectively. In accordance with RoP 54(4), the debates were adjourned and the Bills were referred to the House Committee.

Consideration by committee of the whole Council and Third Reading

- Judicial Officers (Extension of Retirement : Chief Secretary for Administration Age) (Amendment) Bill 2019

The Council became committee of the whole Council and considered the Bill. The question that clauses 1 to 23 stand part of the Bill was proposed. After Members and the public officer had spoken, the question was put and agreed to.

The Council then resumed. The public officer reported that the Bill had been passed by committee of the whole Council without amendment. The question on the motion that the report made under RoP 58(12) by the public officer be adopted by this Council was proposed, put and agreed to. The Bill was ordered to be set down for Third Reading under RoP 59. The question on the Third Reading of the Bill was proposed. After Members had spoken, the question on the Third Reading of the Bill was put and agreed to (details of division in **Appendix 2**). The Bill was read the third time and passed.

Second Reading (debate to resume), consideration by committee of the whole Council and Third Reading

- Electoral Legislation (Miscellaneous : Secretary for Constitutional and Amendments) Bill 2019 Mainland Affairs

The debate on the Second Reading of the Bill, which was moved on 20 March 2019, resumed. After Members and the public officer had spoken, the question on the Second Reading of the Bill was put and agreed to. The Bill was read the second time and committed to a committee of the whole Council.

The Council became committee of the whole Council and considered the Bill. The provisions of the Bill and the amendment to the long title were debated and voted in accordance with the relevant provisions of RoP. During the consideration of the Bill, the following questions were put:

The Bill was ordered to be set down for Third Reading under RoP 59. The question on the Third Reading of the Bill was proposed. After Members and the public officer had spoken, the question on the Third Reading of the Bill was put and agreed to. The Bill was read the third time and passed.
