## **Council meeting of 15 July 2020**

### **Agenda and meeting arrangement**

Further to the preliminary Agenda issued under LC Paper No. CB(3) 624/19-20 on 7 July 2020, I attach the Agenda for the captioned meeting, which will be uploaded onto the Legislative Council website.

2. As Members are aware, the captioned meeting will be the last meeting of the current term of the Legislative Council before prorogation, but there are still a large number of items (including 12 Government bills) that need to be dealt with by the Council. In this connection, the President has discussed with the representatives of Members on the arrangement for the captioned meeting. In the meantime, the COVID-19 outbreak is getting more severe in Hong Kong recently. After taking into account all relevant factors, the President has directed that the captioned meeting will **only deal with the following items** as detailed in the attached **Agenda**:

- (a) laying of papers on the Table of the Council and addresses on the papers;
- (b) questions; and
- (c) Government bills.

3. The arrangement for the captioned meeting is as follows:

<b>15 July (Wednesday)</b>	<b>16 July (Thursday)</b>	<b>17 July (Friday)</b> <i>(if the Council needs to continue to deal with Government bills)</i>
start at 11:00 am	resume at 9:00 am	resume at 8:00 pm
suspend at around 7:00 pm	suspend at around 7:00 pm	adjourn after dealing with all Government bills <b>or</b> at around (but must not be later than) 12:00 midnight
Depending on the meeting progress, the President may <b>adjust the meeting time</b> .		

4. **The President calls on Members to make good use of the Council's time to deal with the various items on the Agenda.** If the Council completes the scrutiny of all the Government bills by 16 July, Council meeting will not be held on 17 July. As many financial proposals are pending consideration by the Finance Committee, if the Council meeting needs not be held on 17 July, the Chairman of the Finance Committee may, depending on the situation, consider calling a Finance Committee meeting that night.
