### **Explanatory Note**

The Maritime Safety Committee of the International Maritime Organization passed resolution MSC.496(105) on 28 April 2022. The resolution adopts amendments to Chapter IV (amongst others) of the Annex to the International Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea, 1974 (*Chapter IV*). This Regulation amends the definition of *Radio Regulations* in section 80B(7) of the Merchant Shipping (Local Vessels) (Safety and Survey) Regulation (Cap. 548 sub. leg. G) (*principal Regulation*) to reflect the relevant amendment to Chapter IV.

2. This Regulation also amends the definition of *river trade limits* in section 2 of the principal Regulation to revise the format of the geographical co-ordinates appearing in that definition.
